The role of autologous fibrin-platelet glue in plastic surgery

To promote wound healing, we used autologous fibrin-platelet glue in 14 patients with skin and soft tissue losses caused by recent trauma or chronic pathology.

The level of improvement was scored, arbitrarily, from 0 to 4. Very favourable results (score 3-4) were seen in 11 out of 14 patients. The glue preparation is very easy, inexpensive and creates excellent and stable hemostasis.

From a general point of view, we have confirmed the utility of fibrin-platelet glue in terms of reduced infections and length of hospital stay.
